SESSION I THE FIRST BAPTIST STRATEGY

The FBC objective is to encourage personal spiritual commitments (covenants).

The Four First Baptist Church Covenants:

- I. The Membership Covenant is a commitment to Christ and a Church Family.
- 2. The Maturity Covenant is a commitment to the **habits** necessary for *spiritual growth*.
- 3. The Ministry Covenant is a commitment to discovering and using my God-given gifts and ability to serve God and others.
- 4. The Mission Covenant is a commitment to **share** the Good News with others.


Why do we have these Covenants?

THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH STRUCTURE




The First Baptist Church Structure

"For God is not a God of disorder, but of peace...

Everything should be done in a fitting and orderly way"

The structure of the church should not be determined by culture, business practices, or even denominational traditions.

DENOMINATION VS RELIGION



I. The Church is a Fellowship.



A top priority in a fellowship is **Harmony and** Unity.

Any attitude that causes disunity is sin.

sin = separation from God

Read I Cor. 1:10

Implication: A good structure promotes unity and downplays differences.

"(Often)... your meetings do more harm than good because I hear when you come together as a church there are divisions among you. I Cor. II:17-18

"Voting" tends to create conflict

At First Baptist, we only vote on:

- Purchase of land or buildings
- Calling the senior pastor (selection)
- Changes in the Church Constitution



II. The Church is a family, so we operate on the basis of relationships not rules.

Read I Peter 3:8



III. The church is a **Body** (of Christ) Read I Cor. 12:27

We are a body, Not a business We are an organism, Not an organization

(living, growing, changing)

Therefore, we function based on Spiritual Gifts not Elected Officers.

In an organization, "maintenance" becomes the focus. But in an "organism" (church), "Ministry" (serving) is the focus.

Our Structure:

The people are the "ministers".

The pastors are the "administers".

At First Baptist, we have a simple structure so we can maximize **ministry** and minimize **maintenance**.



IV. The Church is a Flockof Sheep

Therefore, it is cared for and led by a **Shepherd**.

Read John 10: 1-30

THE FIRST BAPTIST STATEMENTS

"Let there be real harmony among you so there won't be any split in the church. I plead with you to be of one mind, united in thought and purpose"

I Corinthians 1:10 (LB)

What is the purpose of this church?

We believe that a great commitment to the great **COMMISSION** and the great **COMMANDMENT** will grow a great Church.

The <u>Great Commandment</u> - Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, and mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it. Love your neighbor as yourself.

The <u>Great Commission</u> - Go and make disciples of all nations baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and the Holy Spirit and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.

- To love God with all your heart is "Worship"
- To love your neighbor as yourself is "Ministry"
- To go and make disciples is "Evangelism"
- To Baptize is to "Incorporate into Fellowship"
- To teach them all things is "Discipleship"

First Baptist Church exists:

- To Reverence the name of Jesus (Worship)
- To Serve others through ministry (Ministry)
- To Inspire non-believers to follow Christ (Evangelism)
- To Fellowship with other believers (Fellowship)
- To Train/Teach believers to become more like Christ

(Discipleship)



OUR SALVATION

"For now, we are all children of God through faith in Jesus Christ, and we who have been baptized into union with Christ are enveloped by Him. We are no longer Jews or Gentiles, or slaves or free men, or even merely men or women, but we are all the same — we are Christians; we are one in Jesus Christ.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A CHRISTIAN?

Everyone wants to be happy. People try in many ways:

- Some look for happiness by acquiring possessions.
- Some look for happiness by experiencing pleasure.
- Some look for happiness by gaining prestige and power.

But real happiness comes from understanding

my Purpose in Life.

I. Why Am I Here?

- I. God made Me to Love Me. Jer. 31:3
- 2. We were created to **Enjoy** a personal relationship with God and to **Manage** all of the rest of God's creation! This makes us special. Gen. 1:27-28
- 3. When we know and love God and live in Harmony with his purpose for our lives, it produces tremendous benefits in our lives.

II. What is the problem?

Man has a natural desire to **be the Boss** and to ignore God's principles for living.

The bible calls this attitude: Sin

Sin breaks our close relationship with God. It causes us to fear God and to try to live our lives outside of His will.

When our relationship with God is not right, it causes **PROBLEMS** in every area of our lives - marriage, career, relationships, finances, etc.


When People Have Problems, They Often Try Many Different Ways Of Coping Before Turning To God.

Even when we know that our deepest need is God, we often try wrong ways of getting to know Him:

What's the Solution?

Jesus has already taken care of your Sin problem.

God did this for us because he loves us and wants us to know him.



IV. What does God want me to do?

- Admit that God has not been first place in your life and ask for forgiveness.
- Believe that Jesus died to pay for your sins and rose again and is alive today.
- Accept God's Free Gift of Salvation.
- Invite Jesus Christ to come into your life and be the director (Lord of your life).


We can take these steps by praying a simple prayer of commitment to God.

PRAYER OF COMMITMENT TO GOD

"Dear Jesus, thank you for making me and loving me, even when I have ignored you and gone my own way. I realize I need you in my life and I'm sorry for my sins. I ask you to forgive me. Thank you for dying on the cross for me. Please help me to understand it more. As much as I know how, I want to follow you from now on. Please come into my life and make me a new person inside. I accept your gift of salvation. Please help me to grow as a Christian."

"Whoever calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved"

Romans 10:13



The importance of being Baptized.

I. Why should I be baptized?



- 1. To follow the example set by Jesus. Mark 1:9
- 2. Because Christ Commands it. Matt. 28: 19-20
- 3. It demonstrates that I really am a Believer.

Acts 18:8



- II. What is the meaning of Baptism?
 - I. It illustrates Christ's **Death.** I Cor. 5: 3-4
 - 2. It illustrates my New Life as a Christian. 2 Cor. 5:17
- III. Why be baptized by immersion?
 - I. Because Jesus was Baptized that way. Matthew 3: 16
 - 2. Every Baptism in the Bible was by immersion. Acts 8: 38-39

It best symbolizes a burial and resurrection.

IV. WHO SHOULD BE BAPTIZED?

EVERY PERSON WHO BELIEVES IN CHRIST

At First Baptist, it is a membership requirement that every member must have been baptized the way Jesus demonstrated.

V. WHEN SHOULD I BE BAPTIZED?

As soon as you have believed!

The Meaning of the Lord's Supper

ICor. 11:23-26

I. What is the Lord's Supper?

- I. It is a Simple Act.
- 2. It is a Reminder.
- 3. It is a **Symbol.**
- 4. It is a **Statement of Faith.**

II. Who should take the Lord's Supper?

Only those who are already believers Mark 14: 22-26

III. How do I prepare myself for the Lord's Supper?

- I. Self-Examination | Cor. | 1:27
- 2. Confessing My Sins | John 1:19
- 3. Recommitment Rom. 12:19
- 4. Restoring Relationships Matt 5: 23-24

IV. When and how often should we observe the Lord's Supper?

There is no clear command in Scripture to tell us how often we should observe the Lord's Supper. The important thing is that when we partake of the Holy Communion, we do it in remembrance of Jesus Christ, our Lord, and Savior.

The difference between attenders and members can be summed up in one word.......Commitment!

What it means to be a Member:

At First Baptist, we recognize the need for a formal membership. We ask you to commit to membership for four reasons:

WHY COMMIT TO FORMAL MEMBERSHIP

- A Biblical Reason: Christ is committed to the Church.
- A Cultural Reason: It is an antidote to our society. It Builds character.
- A Practical Reason: It defines who can be counted on. It identifies our family.
- A Personal Reason: It produces spiritual growth.
